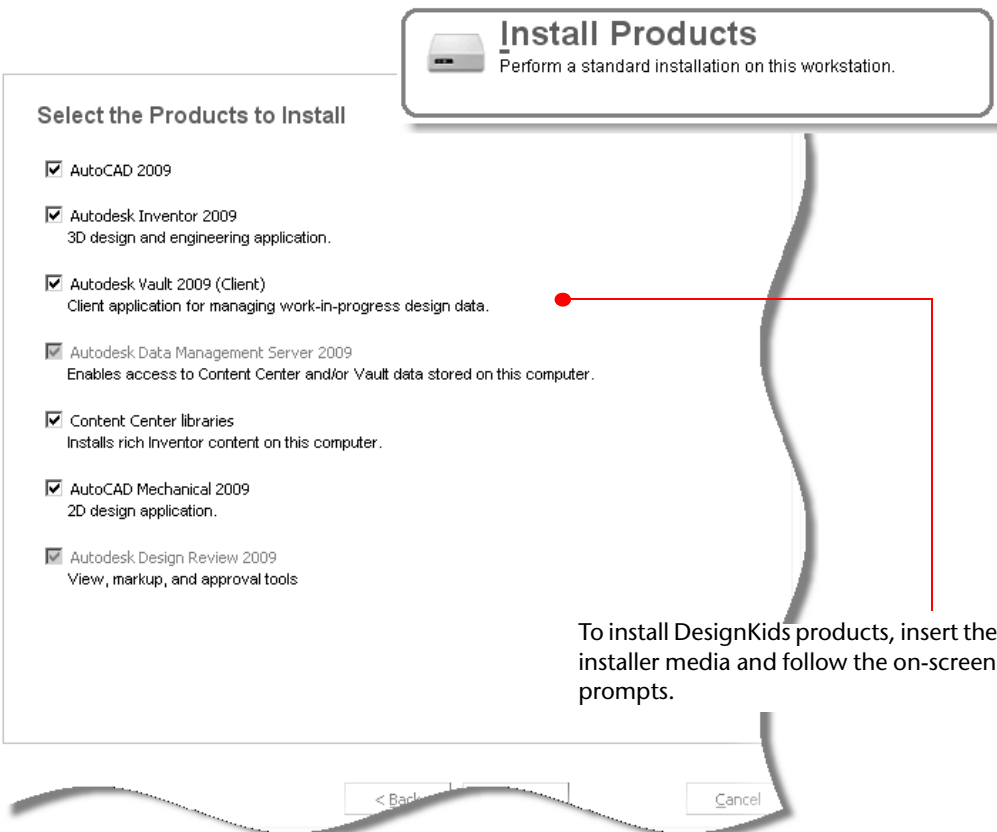
Online Documentation
