

Autodesk Design Institute 2009 License Agreement

IMPORTANT. BY OPENING THE SEALED SOFTWARE PACKET(S) OR INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE, INSTITUTION AGREES TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT (“LICENSE AGREEMENT”). THESE ARE THE ONLY TERMS UPON WHICH THE AUTODESK, INC. (“AUTODESK”) SOFTWARE PRODUCTS (INCLUDING RELATED SUBSCRIPTIONS) ARE LICENSED. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THESE TERMS, WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF PURCHASE, RETURN THE SOFTWARE, THE SOFTWARE PACKAGE (S) AND ALL OTHER ITEMS IN THE PACKAGE, WITH DATED PROOF OF PURCHASE, TO THE LOCATION WHERE YOU ACQUIRED IT FOR A FULL REFUND. YOU MAY NOT USE THE SOFTWARE AND MUST RETURN IT IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT. NO REFUND WILL BE GRANTED ONCE THE AUTHORIZATION CODE HAS BEEN ISSUED. THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT SUPERCEDES ANY END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT THAT MAY APPEAR WHEN INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE.

COPYING THE COMPUTER PROGRAM(S) OR DOCUMENTATION EXCEPT AS PERMITTED BY THIS LICENSE IS COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT UNDER THE LAWS OF YOUR COUNTRY. IF YOU COPY AUTODESK COMPUTER PROGRAM(S) WITHOUT PERMISSION OF AUTODESK, YOU ARE VIOLATING THE LAW. YOU MAY BE LIABLE TO AUTODESK FOR DAMAGES, AND YOU MAY BE SUBJECT TO CRIMINAL PENALTIES.

1. DEFINITIONS.

- 1.1 “ADI” means the Autodesk Design Institute program that allows educational institutions to purchase certain Autodesk products (inclusive of related Subscription) in different ADI License Solution packages, each as set forth in detail in the Order Form and which solution packages may be changed from time to time by Autodesk in its sole discretion.
- 1.2 “ADI License Solution” means certain Autodesk product (inclusive of related Subscription) in different solution packages, each as set forth in detail in the Order Form and which ADI License Solution packages may be changed from time to time by Autodesk in its sole discretion
- 1.3 “Ancillary Product” means any product (other than an Extension or a Release) which Autodesk may furnish to Institution from time to time as part of Subscription.
- 1.4 “Ancillary Services” means any services or benefits (other than, where applicable, delivery of an Extension, Release or Ancillary Product) which may be provided to Institution from time to time as part of Subscription (or an Autodesk publication analogous thereto) published and/or amended by Autodesk from time to time. Autodesk reserves the right at its discretion to add or remove Ancillary Services to the Subscription from time to time, without prior notification to Institution, and to make them available only in English. Some Ancillary Services may not be available for some software products .
- 1.5 "Documentation" means the manuals, handbooks, brochures, folders or other publications, in printed or digital form, that are included in or accompany the Software and which describe its qualities, characteristics, installation, use or other aspects.
- 1.6 “End User License Agreement” or “EULA” means the then-current license agreement shipped with, or incorporated in, each item of Software, which sets forth the terms and conditions under which the end-user may use such Software.

- 1.7 "Extension" means a license to use a modular addition to the Software incorporating corrections, enhancements or Subscription information which supplement and enhance that Software.
- 1.8 "Faculty" means only those who are employed personnel of the Institution during the Term of the license.
- 1.9 "Host Server" means the computer hardware used by an Institution to host and deliver the Software over the Institution's secure, privately maintained computer network, or Intranet, which network is accessible only by permitted employees, Faculty and Students of the Institution.
- 1.10 "Institution" shall mean the educational institution that has licensed the Software as listed on the Order Form. Such Institution shall include secondary educational institutions, such as high schools, two-year or four-year degree granting educational institutions or a nine-month certificate-granting career schools, each of which shall be recognized or accredited by the appropriate governmental agency in the Institution's jurisdiction.
- 1.11 "Institution Content" means the content and software application(s), if any, owned or licensed by Institution that is (are) served up to Users in conjunction with the Self-hosted Product.
- 1.12 "Institution Site" means an Institution's Main Site as set forth in the Order Form, and, if set forth in the Order Form, an Institution's Remote or Satellite site.
- 1.13 "Main Site" means the computer labs, classrooms, or offices located on Institution's primary campus and does not include (i) any computer labs, classrooms, or offices located on any of Institution's Remote or Satellite sites, (ii) Institution-owned computers that Institution has leased or provided to Students outside of the computer labs, classrooms, or offices located on Institution's primary campus, or (iii) or Student or Faculty personal computers. Institution may designate only one primary campus as its Main Site. An Institution's Main Site is subject to prior written approval by Autodesk.
- 1.14 "Order Form" means the Autodesk order form that Institution submits with its ADI purchase order for the Software.
- 1.15 "Release" means a full commercial version of the Software incorporating all Extensions relating to that Software offered by Autodesk since the preceding version of that Software and which enhances or improves the functionality of the preceding version of that Software, and for which Autodesk normally charges a fee. A Release includes the documentation customarily provided by Autodesk with the Software. A "Release" does not include: (a) an Extension; or (b) a future Autodesk computer program that is a separate product and not a direct successor to the Software.
- 1.16 "Remote or Satellite site" means the computer labs, classrooms or offices located on a campus of Institution other than the primary/main campus. A Remote or Satellite site (i) may have a separate physical address, location but must have the same financial management as the Main Site; (ii) must be located within the same geographical state or province as the Main Site; and (iii) must be of the same brand with the same primary curriculum focus as the main campus (i.e., if the main campus is a technology school, the remote or satellite site must also be a technology school and not a business school). A remote or Satellite site does not include (i) any Institution-owned computers that Institution has leased or provided to Students, outside of the computer labs, classrooms, or offices located on Institution's remote or satellite campus, or (ii) Student or Faculty personal computers. Designation of an Institution's Remote or Satellite site is subject to prior written approval by Autodesk.

- 1.17 “Self-hosting Services” means Host Servers owned, leased or licensed by Institution that serve up web pages on which the Software is made available to permitted Users over Institution’s secure privately maintained computer network, or Intranet, which network is accessible only by permitted employees, Faculty and Students of the Institution.
- 1.18 “Self-hosting System” means any operating system, database software or application software, including bug fixes, new versions, updates, improvements and enhancements used by Institution in providing the Self-hosting Services.
- 1.19 “Software” means the Autodesk software programs set forth in the Order Form and includes, without limitation, programs included in the ADI License Solution each as may be detailed and set forth in the Order Form.
- 1.20 “Student” shall mean a person enrolled in at least three (3) credit hours in a course concerning the design, technology or engineering disciplines at a degree granting or certificate granting Institution or a person enrolled in a class concerning the design technology or engineering disciplines at a post-secondary and/or secondary educational Institution such as a high school.
- 1.21 “Subscription” means the entitlement to receive Extensions, Releases, Ancillary Products, Ancillary Services, if any, made available by Autodesk during the Term.
- 1.22 “User” means a permitted end user that Institution may authorize to use the Software as set forth in this Section 1.20. Institution may permit Students or Faculty to use the Software in accordance with the terms of this License Agreement for educational instruction purposes only and only for use at the Main Site or Remote or Satellite site, if applicable.

2. LICENSE GRANT.

UNLESS OTHERWISE SET FORTH IN THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT, THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT (A) APPLY TO ALL SOFTWARE LICENSES PURCHASED AS PART OF THE ADI PROGRAM AND (B) SUPERSEDES ANY END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT THAT APPEARS WHEN INSTALLING THE SOFTWARE TO THE EXTENT SUCH END USER LICENSE AGREEMENT CONFLICTS WITH THE LICENSE AGREEMENT.

- 2.1 In consideration of the license fees paid by Institution as set forth in the Order Form, Autodesk grants to Institution a non-exclusive, non-transferable license to reproduce and use the Software during the Term of this License Agreement solely for the purposes of educational instruction, administration, not-for-profit adult education or continuing education, or facilities management and not for any commercial or for profit purposes, including corporate training. Institution may not sell, license or otherwise transfer the Software or any license granted under this License Agreement to any third parties including, but not limited to, Students or Faculty; nor shall Institution allow any third party to use the Software, except for Users. Further, departments or divisions within Institution may not sell, license or otherwise transfer the Software to other departments or divisions within Institution for profit. Reproduction and use of the Software by Institution shall at all times be strictly in accordance with the terms of this License Agreement and the terms of the Order Form. Institution shall make the terms of this License Agreement available to Users. Except as set forth in Section 2.2.5, Student and Faculty use of the Software is permitted only pursuant to the terms of this License Agreement, is only permitted at Institution’s Main Site or Remote or Satellite site, if applicable, and Students and Faculty may not use the Software on Student or Faculty-owned or leased personal

computers. Institution shall be responsible for enforcing the terms of this License Agreement.

2.2 Institution may reproduce copies of the Software and Documentation solely in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

2.2.1 Institution may reproduce for use only the Software bearing the unique serial number assigned by Autodesk to the Institution Site.

2.2.2 Institution may install and operate the Software either i) only on that number of computers that is equivalent to the number of licenses for which Institution has paid the then-current license fees as set forth in the Order Form and the number of concurrent Users at any time shall be no more than such number of licenses. (For example, if the Order Form provides for the purchase of twenty-five (25) licenses to use the Software, then this License Agreement permits Institution to install the Software on twenty-five (25) individual computers located on the Institution Site and allows for the use of the Software by no more than twenty-five (25) Users at any one time); or ii) if the Order Form specifies that the Software may be used over an internal local area network, then Institution may use the Software over such network environment and may install and operate the Software only on a single server computer located on the Institution Site that may be accessed by other computers, or on an individual computer located on the Institution Site as a multiple-user installation, with, in both cases, the maximum number of concurrent Users being equal to the total number of licenses purchased as set forth in the Order Form; or iii) in a manner that allows for use on both individual computers and over an internal local area network as set forth in 2.2.2(i) and 2.2.2(ii) above; provided, however, that the total number of concurrent Users shall be equal to the total number of licenses purchased as set forth in the Order Form.

2.2.3 If Institution is deploying a network version of the Software as set forth above, such use is subject to the following conditions: (i) use of the Software must be controlled by a license management system approved by Autodesk and must meet any security requirements required by Autodesk; (ii) concurrent use may not exceed fully paid licenses; (iii) use is limited to those Users permitted pursuant to the terms and conditions of this License Agreement; (iv) network use shall be deployed in the following manner: Institution shall have the right to reproduce, store on the Host Servers, display, use, and serve up to permitted Users the object code version of the Software only for the purpose of providing the Self-hosting Services to permitted Users and which such services shall be accessed and used solely at the Institution Site; (v) Institution is solely responsible for the performance of the Software as it is integrated with any Institution Self-hosting System to provide the Self-hosting Services; (vi) Institution shall provide Users with Intranet access to the Self-hosting Services, including the Software, through a combination of protected usernames and password(s); (vii) Institution may instruct Users to download certain object code but only if such downloading is necessary to enable the Self-hosted Product to run on an User's computer; (viii) Institution shall upgrade its security measures as may be reasonably necessary to ensure that at all times it has the most current security protection; and (ix) Institution shall be solely and exclusively responsible for the care, upkeep, maintenance, and safeguarding of the Host Servers and all associated costs.

2.2.4 Institution may use the Software and Documentation only at the Institution Site(s) listed in the Order Form and at no other location or site; provided, however, that the Software and Documentation shall only be made available to

Students and Faculty authorized by the Institution to use the Software in accordance with this License Agreement.

- 2.2.5 Notwithstanding the restrictions set forth in Sections 2.2.2 and 2.2.3 above, Institution may permit Faculty teaching courses utilizing the Software to install one (1) copy of such Software on such Faculty member's personal computer solely to facilitate classroom instruction and preparation.
- 2.2.6 Institution shall appoint an administrator who shall be solely responsible for making and administering copies of the Software and the Documentation. Institution is authorized to make a reasonable number of copies of the Documentation that it receives in electronic form on any master CDs distributed with the Software as long as such copies are used in furtherance of or in connection with Institution's authorized use of the Software as set forth in this License Agreement.
- 2.2.7 Institution may make and retain one (1) archival copy of the Software for the sole purpose of replacing the original copy provided by Autodesk in the event of damage to or destruction of the said original.
- 2.2.8 Autodesk reserves the right to audit Institution during normal business hours, upon twenty-four (24) hours notice, to determine whether Institution, or other parties, is in compliance with all terms and sections of this License Agreement.

3. AUTODESK DESIGN INSTITUTE SUBSCRIPTION.

- 3.1 **Subscription Grant.** Autodesk grants Institution a Subscription for each Software listed on the Order Form or Autodesk order confirmation, as applicable, for the Term. Institution's use of Extensions, Releases and Ancillary Products shall be governed by the terms of the EULA included with them, or in the absence of an EULA, by the EULA included with the Software to which the Extension, Release or Ancillary Product relates. Institution may only use an Extension or a Release to replace or supplement a prior version of the Software. Institution may not distribute, rent, loan, sell, sublicense or otherwise transfer or market any Software, Extension, Release, Ancillary Product or Ancillary Services to any other person without Autodesk's prior written consent. Institution must be registered with Autodesk as the holder of a copy of the most current version of the Software.
- 3.2 **Ancillary Services.** Autodesk may provide Ancillary Services to Institution subject to and in accordance with these terms and conditions and any supplementary terms and conditions and customer obligations applicable to each type of Ancillary Service, which applicable supplementary terms and conditions and customer obligations must be accepted by Institution prior to accessing and using those Ancillary Services. Unless and until Institution accepts the supplemental terms and conditions applicable to a particular Ancillary Service, Institution agrees that Autodesk is under no obligation to provide such Ancillary Service to Institution.

AUTODESK DOES NOT GUARANTEE THAT IT WILL MAKE AVAILABLE, AND INSTITUTION ACKNOWLEDGES THAT INSTITUTION MAY NOT RECEIVE, ANY EXTENSION, RELEASE, ANCILLARY PRODUCT OR ANCILLARY SERVICE DURING THE TERM.

- 3.3 **Use of Previous Versions**
 - 3.3.1 Notwithstanding anything contained in the EULA accompanying the Software licensed to Institution or any Release or Extension provided to Institution, for

the Term, Institution may install and continue to use prior versions of the Software that Institution has licensed, provided that Institution purchased and has a valid license to use such prior versions and those prior versions validly remain in Institution's possession ("Previous Versions") and provided, further that the following conditions are met: (i) use of the Previous Versions shall be subject to the provisions of the applicable EULA, as modified by this Section 3.3; (ii) subject to subsection 3.3.4 below, the number of Previous Version licenses that Institution may use and install shall not exceed the total number of licenses of the Software that Institution has paid the then-current license fees; (iii) the Software and all the Previous Versions of such Software shall be installed on the same computer; (iv) neither the Software nor any of the Previous Versions of the Software shall be used concurrently; (v) the Previous Versions or any permitted copies thereof, are not transferred to another computer unless all permitted copies of the Software are also transferred to the same computer; and (vi) Institution is hereby acknowledging and agreeing that Autodesk does not have any obligation to provide support for the Previous Versions other than as set forth herein and any such obligations may be ended at any time. Additionally, if this Software is a Network Version, then Institution's Users may continue to use this Software or the Previous Versions as long as the maximum number of concurrent users of any version of the Software does not exceed the maximum number of licenses of the Software licensed to Institution and under Subscription.

- 3.3.2 Autodesk shall have the right to conduct an audit on Institution's premises or by electronic means (with reasonable notice) to ensure that Institution's use of all/any versions of the Software complies with the provisions of this License Agreement. In the event any audit discloses a breach of this License Agreement, Autodesk reserves the right to terminate this License Agreement and/or recover damages, attorney's fees, and costs, including the cost of the audit.
- 3.3.3 In the event Autodesk in connection with the Software licensed to User hereunder provides User additional software that supplements or extends the Software, that additional software shall be subject to the terms and conditions of this License Agreement unless otherwise specified at the time of delivery.
- 3.3.4 For the avoidance of doubt, nothing herein requires Autodesk to supply Institution with media containing Previous Versions of the Software or related documentation or to issue additional authorization codes or hardware or software locks. Moreover, Autodesk reserves the right to charge a transaction fee for the issuance or re-issuance of authorization codes, hardware locks or software locks. Further, if the Previous Version of a Software has been retired or otherwise discontinued by Autodesk, Institution agrees and acknowledges that i) in no event is Autodesk required to issue authorization codes or hardware or software locks to Institution to enable Institution to use or install such retired or discontinued Previous Versions; and ii) these Previous Version rights do not allow Institution to use or install additional licenses (i.e. more than Institution held or originally validly licensed) of any Previous Version of a Software that has been retired or otherwise discontinued by Autodesk.
- 3.3.5 Design Institute Subscription may include telephone technical support solely for installation and activation as set forth in the Order Form. Additionally, annual product fulfillment may be included when available. In the event of a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Order Form and this License Agreement, the terms and conditions of this License Agreement shall prevail.

4. TERM AND TERMINATION.

4.1 Term.

Unless otherwise provided, the term of this License Agreement shall be for one (1) year from the period beginning on the date of invoice of the Software to Institution as evidenced by Autodesk's shipment or invoice date, unless earlier terminated as set forth herein ("Term"). Autodesk reserves the right to terminate or cancel any renewal term if Institution has not submitted the then-current license fees, order form and purchase order within thirty (30) days of any renewal date. Purchases of any additional licenses of Software shall be at the then-current price.

4.2 Termination For Cause.

In the event of a breach of this License Agreement, the non-defaulting party may terminate this License Agreement upon not less than thirty (30) days written notice to the other, provided such default is not cured within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice of such default by the defaulting party. Failure by Institution to pay any amounts when due or to comply with Section 2 of this License Agreement shall be considered a material breach of this License Agreement.

4.3 Termination Upon Cancellation of the Program.

In the event that Autodesk discontinues the ADI program, this License Agreement will terminate at the end of the current Term as set forth in Section 4.1 and there shall be no automatic renewal. In the event that Autodesk replaces the ADI program with a similar program during the Term, Autodesk shall make such program available to Institution for the remaining months of the Term. Autodesk reserves the right to determine if an additional program fee shall apply for the new program.

4.4 Effect of Termination.

Upon termination of this License Agreement for any reason, all rights of Institution and Student, if any, under this License Agreement, including, without limitation, Institution's and Student's right to reproduce and use the Software and Documentation shall terminate. Institution shall immediately (a) delete all copies of the Software and the Documentation from its computers and (b) destroy all Media containing copies of the Software and all Documentation in Institution's and Student's possession and certify such deletion and destruction to Autodesk.

5. RESTRICTIONS.

Institution and User may neither do, nor permit another party to do the following:

- (a) copy the Software or Documentation except as permitted by this License Agreement;
- (b) reverse engineer, decompile or disassemble the Software except to the extent permitted by law where this is indispensable to obtain the information necessary to achieve interoperability of an independently created program with the Software or with another program and such information is not readily available from Autodesk or elsewhere. Institution may not decompile the Software if such information is available by licensing any Autodesk Software Developer's Kit through an authorized Autodesk partner or representative or through any Autodesk office;

- (c) distribute, rent, loan, lease, sell, sublicense or otherwise transfer all or part of the Software, Documentation or any rights granted hereunder to any other person or onto any Student or Faculty personal computer (except as set forth in Section 2.2.5) without the prior written consent of Autodesk or unless otherwise provided herein;
- (d) remove, alter or obscure any proprietary notices, labels or marks from the Software or Documentation;
- (e) modify, translate, adapt, arrange or create derivative works based on the Software or Documentation for any purpose;
- (f) utilize any equipment, device, software or other means designed to circumvent or remove any form of copy protection used by Autodesk in connection with the Software, or use the Software together with any hardware lock, authorization code, serial number, or other copy protection device not supplied by Autodesk directly or through an authorized Autodesk representative or partner, unless authorized by Autodesk; provided, however, that to the extent the Software is used together with any device or product not supplied by Autodesk directly or through an authorized Autodesk representative or partner, Institution agrees that Autodesk shall not be responsible for the support or maintenance of any such use by Institution or Student, if applicable;
- (g) use the Software or Documentation outside of the country in which it was purchased;
- (h) export the Software or Documentation in violation of U.S. or other applicable export control laws;
- (i) provide access to the Software or Documentation to any person or entity other than Users expressly authorized by Institution.

6. COPYRIGHT.

Title and copyrights to the Software, Documentation and accompanying materials and any copies made by Institution remain with Autodesk. Unauthorized copying of the Software or Documentation, or failure to comply with the above restrictions, will result in automatic termination of this License Agreement.

7. LIMITED WARRANTIES.

Autodesk warrants that for a ninety (90) day period beginning on the date of delivery of the Software to Institution, as evidenced by Institution's receipt, the Software will provide the facilities and functions generally described in the Documentation and that the Media on which the Software is furnished, the Documentation accompanying the Software, and any hardware lock or other copy protection device accompanying the Software will be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use.

EXCEPT FOR THE ABOVE EXPRESS LIMITED WARRANTIES, AUTODESK MAKES AND INSTITUTION RECEIVES NO WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS, EXPRESS, IMPLIED, STATUTORY OR IN ANY COMMUNICATION WITH INSTITUTION, AND AUTODESK SPECIFICALLY DISCLAIMS ANY OTHER WARRANTY OR CONDITION INCLUDING THE IMPLIED WARRANTY OR CONDITION OF MERCHANTABILITY, NON-INFRINGEMENT, OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. AUTODESK DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE OPERATION OF THE SOFTWARE, EXTENSIONS, RELEASES, ANCILLARY PRODUCTS, ANCILLARY SERVICES OR SUPPORT WILL BE

UNINTERRUPTED OR ERROR FREE. IN NO EVENT WILL AUTODESK BE LIABLE FOR DAMAGES FOR FAILURE TO MANUFACTURE OR MAKE COMMERCIALY AVAILABLE EXTENSIONS, RELEASES, ANCILLARY PRODUCTS OR ANCILLARY SERVICES OR SUPPORT DURING THE TERM. IN NO EVENT SHALL AUTODESK BE LIABLE FOR COSTS OF PROCUREMENT OF SUBSTITUTE GOODS OR SERVICES. The above exclusions may not apply to Institution as some jurisdictions do not allow the exclusion of implied warranties. In addition to the above warranty rights, Institution may also have other rights, which vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.

Autodesk's entire liability and Institution's exclusive remedy under the warranties made in this License Agreement will be, at Autodesk's option, to attempt to correct or work around errors, to replace the defective Media, Documentation, or copy protection device, or to refund the license fee and terminate this License Agreement. This remedy is subject to the return of the defective Media, Documentation, or copy protection device with a copy of Institution's receipt to Institution's local Autodesk office or the authorized Autodesk representative from whom it was obtained within ninety (90) days from the date of its delivery to Institution. Following expiration of this ninety (90)-day period, Autodesk will replace any defective or damaged copy protection device in return for payment of an amount which covers the cost of a replacement device plus a fee for handling and shipment.

Institution Warranty. Institution represents and warrants to Autodesk that: (i) it has all necessary rights in and to all copyrights, patents and other proprietary rights associated with the Self-hosting System and the Institution Content and its exploitation to offer the Self-hosting Services as contemplated by this License Agreement; and (ii) the Self-hosting System and the Institution Content do not violate any third party rights, including but not limited to intellectual property rights, and their use as described in this License Agreement will not violate any third party rights.

8. DISCLAIMER.

COMPUTER-AIDED DESIGN SOFTWARE AND OTHER TECHNICAL SOFTWARE ARE TOOLS INTENDED TO BE USED BY TRAINED PROFESSIONALS ONLY. THEY ARE NOT SUBSTITUTES FOR PROFESSIONAL JUDGMENT. COMPUTER-AIDED DESIGN SOFTWARE AND OTHER TECHNICAL SOFTWARE ARE INTENDED TO ASSIST WITH PRODUCT DESIGN AND ARE NOT SUBSTITUTES FOR INDEPENDENT TESTING OF PRODUCT STRESS, SAFETY AND UTILITY.
